

Islands and Coasts

- ★ Exploring the oceans and the seas across the world.
- ★ Exploring coastal features and finding out how beaches are formed.
- ★ Learning about significant explorers of the sea.
- ★ We explore stories and adventures of pirates.
- ★ Comparing life in different geographical regions.

RE Learning:

- ★ Pentecost: Serving We learn about 'spreading the word' as we explore the time of Pentecost and Good News.
- ★ Reconciliation: Interrelating We learn about the reasons for rules in the Christian Sacrament of Reconciliation.
- ★ Universal Church: World We explore the treasures God gave us in the World.

Art Learning:

- ★ Observational drawings of shells.
- ★ Design and create a sculpture.
- ★ Using different media and techniques to create 'sea themed' pictures.

Have you ever spotted hidden sculptures around your area?

English Learning:

- ★ Looking at exciting story books about pirates and using them as inspiration for our writing.
- ★ Continue to develop our skills as writers and readers.
- ★ Widening our vocabulary and use of punctuation.
- ★ Exploring different forms of writing including letters, diaries, information pages, character descriptions, stories and many more.

Maths Learning:

- ★ Learning 2, 5 and 10 times tables off by heart.
- ★ Counting in 3's.
- ★ Finding $\frac{1}{2}$, $\frac{1}{4}$ $\frac{3}{4}$ fractions and equivalent $\frac{2}{4}$ fractions.
- ★ Reading scales of numbers.
- ★ Adding money and working out change.
- ★ Measuring and weighing using m, cm, kg, and l.
- ★ Telling time to half and quarter hours.
- ★ Identify and explore common 2D and 3D shapes.

Science Learning: Animals and habitats

- ★ Look at food chains for different species.
- ★ Explore what has lived, has stopped living and has never lived.
- ★ Look at different habitats, where do different animals live?



DT Learning:

- ★ Researching different 'sea themed' cake designs and recipes.
- ★ Looking at the ingredients and method used to make cup cakes.
