- ★ Who were the Spartan warriors and how did they live & fight?
- ★ What traditions and customs did the Ancient Greeks have?
- ★ What lasting impact can we see today from the Ancient?
- ★ What happened at the Battle of Marathon?
- ★ Was there a divide between men and women, rich and poor?

# Topic Activities will include:

- ★ Learning about The Ancient Greeks and its lasting impact in Greece & Britain
- ★ Exploring (and eating!) Ancient Greek food
- ★ Using maps, atlases and ICT to compare the landscape and climate of Britain and Greece
- ★ Looking at the impact that the Ancient Greeks have had on our knowledge of Earth & Space (linking to our science topic of 'Space'.
- ★ Sculpture to create Greek pots made of clay
- ★ Encorporating the Greek Olympics into dance lessons
- ★ Enjoying a 'Greek Day' which involves udressing up as an Ancient Greek!

# **English Learning**

- ★ Exploring 'The Adventures of Odysseus' to learn our English skills
- ★ Recognising different purposes for writing and adapting our writing style to suit
- ★ Explore non-chronological reports and formal writing.
- ★ Developing of use of vocabulary to build imagery and atmosphere in our creative writing.
- ★ Exploring the features of playscripts before writing our own.
- ★ Using inference and comprehension skills to have a better understanding of a character
- ★ Discovering cohesive devices to improve the quality of our writing.

# **Maths Learning**

- ★ Accessing 2-12 times tables quickly and easily to support other methods
- ★ Recognising and comparing numbers to ten million
- ★ Rounding and estimating to the nearest 10, 100 and 1000
- ★ Using a calculator effectively
- ★ Multiplying and dividing by 10, 100 or 1000
- ★ Understanding the correct order of operations
- ★ Mixed numbers and fractions
- ★ Recognising the difference between like and unlike fractions
- ★ Converting fractions to decimals
- ★ Word problems covering our current area of learning.

## You could support your child's learning at home by:

- ★ Looking out for books, documentaries and information about Ancient Greeks and help your child to record useful facts.
- ★ Practising times tables up to 12x12 and reading at least 5 times a week with your child.

- ★ I review, analyse and evaluate my own and others' strengths and weaknesses.
- ★ I can read and react to different situations as they develop. I can develop methods to outwit opponents. I can recognise and suggest patterns of play which will increase chances of success.

- $\star$  Describing the movement of the Moon relative to the Earth
- ★ Exploring and explaining the Earths rotation, and the apparent movement of the Sun across the sky.

#### RE Learning

- ★ Understanding the term 'covenant' and what it means.
- ★ Exploring and understanding the 10 commandments, what they mean and how we can live our lives following them.
- ★ Learning about key figures in the family of God including Moses.
- ★ Learning about Moses' journey including the 10 plagues, parting of the Red Sea and living in the Promised Land.
- ★ King David and the Psalms that he wrote.
- Recognising the link between Jesus and King David.
- Isaiah and his prophecies around the birth of Jesus.
- ★ Looking at God's gift of love, hope and friendship through the birth of Jesus.

What covenants have you made as a family together? What family stories do you have that you remember and share regularly? Does your family have a favourite Saint? What family traditions do you have at Advent?

### Computing Learning

- ★ We are Music Producers: exploring how simple online software can enable us to create patterns, sequences and drum rythms. We will be creating music individually and in small groups.
- ★ We will learn about our responsibilities online and how we can keep ourselves and each other safe and happy.
- ★ Using the school VLE to add work, communicate with others and engage in class discussions.
- ★ We will be developing our presentation skills with opportunities to develop our public speaking whilst using ICT to supportour communication.
